**Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** qualifies students for Federal Aid and is based on need. Financial Aid is given in the following forms: **Loans** (money that is borrowed and must be paid back), **Grants** (money awarded that does not need to be paid back) and **Work Study** (money paid to student for work done on campus).

Students can fill out the FAFSA starting January 1st of their senior year. Aid is first come first serve. The priority deadline for all colleges and universities varies; please check each individual institution for these dates.
