- ▶ Reach proficiency on challenging State and National Academic Achievement Standards and State Academic Assessments.

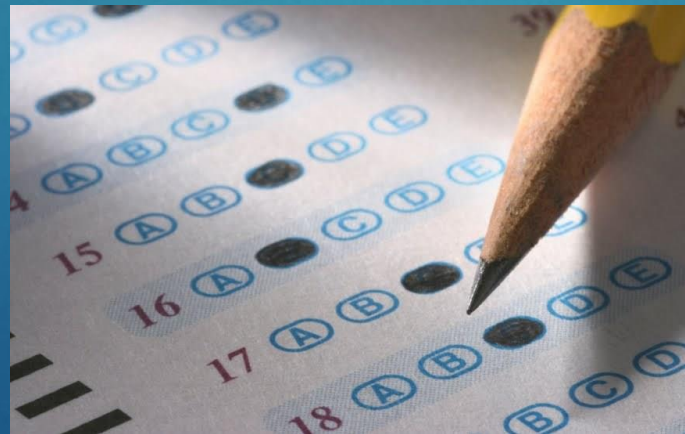
Title I Tutoring

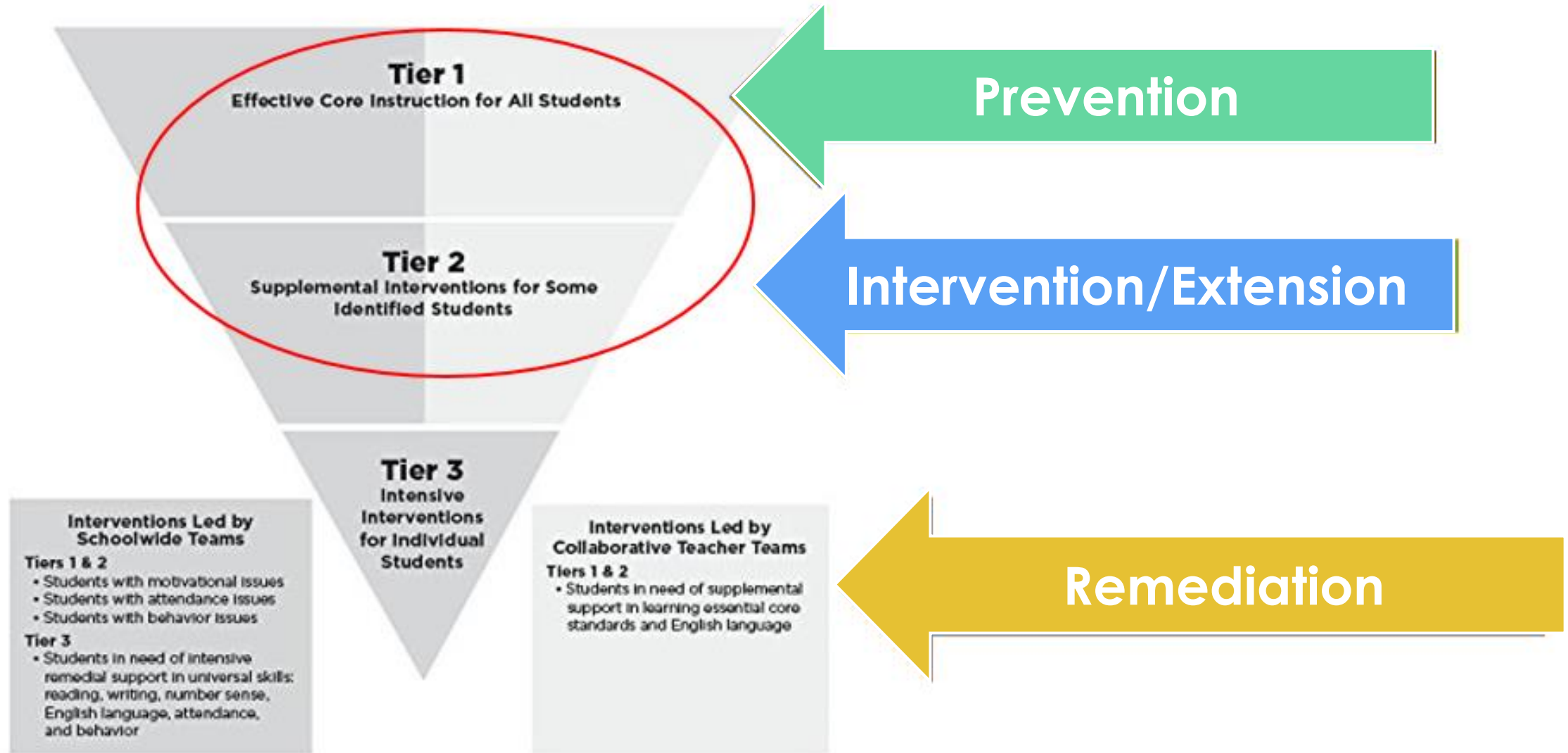
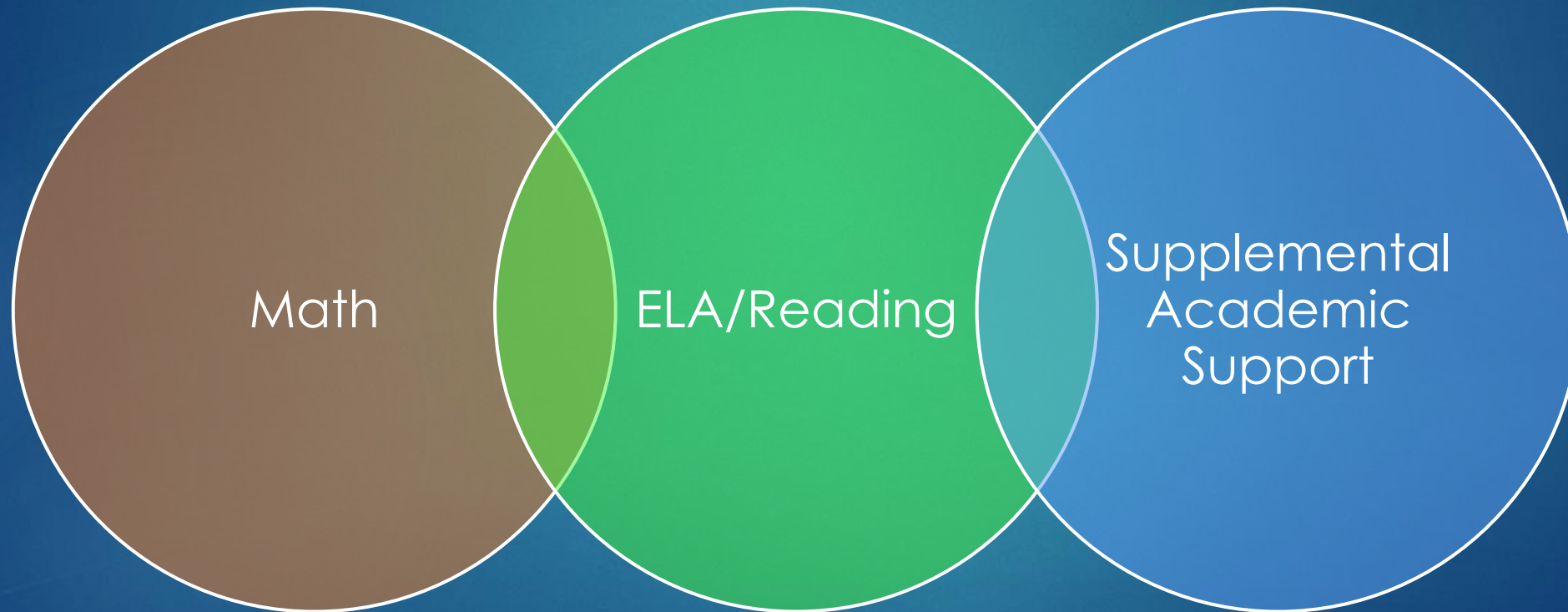


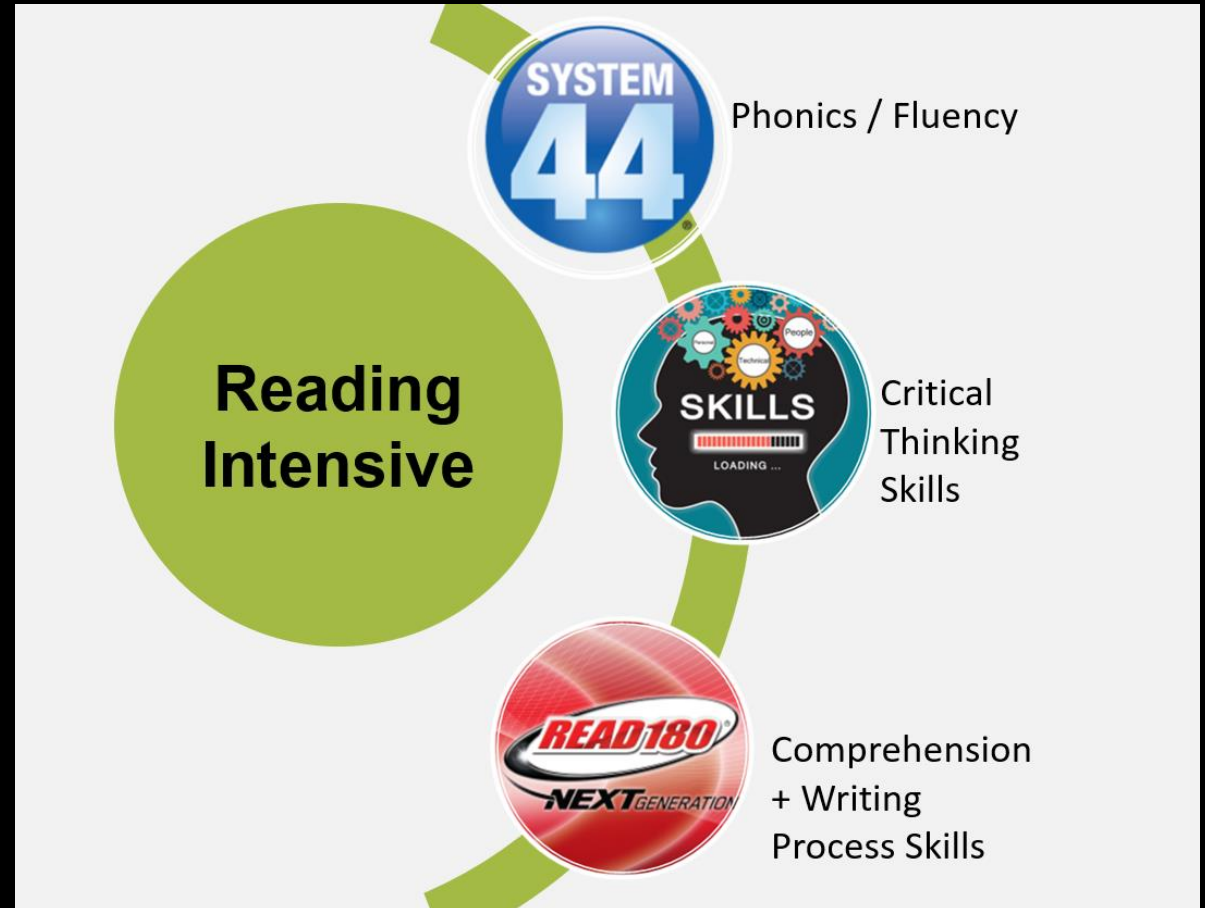
Figure 1.3: Team responsibilities in the Inverted RTI pyramid.

- ▶ Literacy coach supports the program



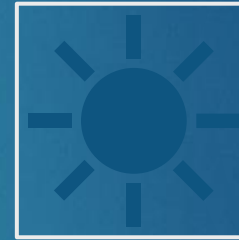
Positive Behavior Intervention & Supports (PBIS)


